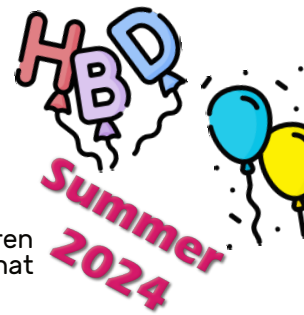




Happy Birthday Camp Evergreen!

Welcome to Camp Evergreen!

Post this calendar on your refrigerator and check it daily so your child will be prepared for every exciting day at camp! The staff are eager to make this the BEST SUMMER EVER!

The schedule is an "on-going" schedule. It lists many of the important days at camp and explains the activities that are offered during the afternoon free choice. Each week has a theme with daily related activities. Friday is "Crazy Dress Up" theme Day. We love seeing what the kids come up with! Sporting events are held through out the summer with major tournaments noted on the calendar.

The Daily Schedule:

The normal camp day begins at 9:00am. After morning Flagpole, campers follow a daily schedule with their tent. Each tent will circulate through each of the "specialist" activities once a week. Tents are scheduled to swim at least once a day. Lunch is at noon. After lunch, campers will have the opportunity to participate in Free Choice activities with the rest of their unit. At the end of the day, campers meet for afternoon Flagpole before being dismissed at 3:55pm.

Sessions:

Sessions are two weeks long and are indicated by the alternating colors on the calendar. Each session has a fishing derby, a canoe trip, and a Late Night scheduled.

Weeks are numbered 1-9. You must sign up for a full, two week session before adding weeks or skipping weeks. You may not start camp in the middle of a session. You may extend when summer is in session provided there is availability in your campers group.

All Camp Get Together:

On Friday afternoons the whole camp meets together at the outdoor theater for awards and entertainment! This is when campers and staff present their talents in front of the entire camp! We encourage all campers to take the stage and shine!

Notes and Emails:

Notes and emails are important methods of communication to the counselors and administration throughout the summer. Any communication concerning medication for campers, swimming issues, camp issues, early dismissal, or alternate pick up should be emailed to the office, given directly to the traffic team, or put in the drop box. Please don't leave notes in your child's backpack. Emails to the camp office are checked hourly during the camp day.

Canoe Trips:

Canoeing is a fun way to experience nature, learn team work, and have fun! Canoe Trips are for campers in Unit's 2 and 3 and will be offered as a free choice activity for those who wish to participate. Canoe trips are scheduled once a session and take place in the Harold Parker State Forest.

Sign-ups for Canoe trips will be held during free choice early in the week. Campers must sign up and attend the Canoe Club training in order to go on the trip.

Campers who sign up should come to camp the morning of the trip already wearing their bathing suits under their camp

clothes. Lunch should be packed in a waterproof bag and campers should bring a hat to wear while on the water. Please note that only deep end swimmers will be allowed on canoe trips.

Fishing Derbies:

Fishing will be offered as a free choice activity for campers in Units 2 and 3 once a session. Camp will provide all the equipment and bait for a great fishing adventure!

Late Nights:

Late Nights are the best! What could be more fun than spending even more time at camp? Late Nights are offered every other week on Wednesdays for Units 2 and 3 only. Our younger campers in Unit 1 and 2 will have the opportunity to attend *Buddy & Bella's Mini Late Night* week 5.

Permission slips will be sent out the week before the scheduled Late Night. We recommend you send your camper in prepared with an extra long sleeved shirt and pants for the evening campfire. We will provide bug spray. We will provide dinner, juice, and a snack before campfire. *Extra fees apply.*

Extended Summer:

This is the only one week session available during the summer. Special events include a 3-D archery shoot, the Warrior Games, and fort building! Campers work all week long to create their own village made out of natural materials! We finish the week with a favorite Camp Evergreen tradition, the Village Camp Out! This week is only open to campers who have finished kindergarten or older, unless they have previously attended a full session of camp.

Enrollment is limited so sign up early if you are interested in registering for this special week of camp.

Celebrating Birthdays:

Your child's birthday can be celebrated with your camper's entire tent! If you wish to drop off goodies they must be store bought and individually packaged. Please drop off the items at morning drop off. Please include a note to the counselor indicating these items are at camp so the counselor may make arrangements for a lunchtime party.

Vacation Camp:

School Vacation Camp is a wonderful way for your child to unplug and get the most out of their school vacation. Spring Vacation Camp will be held April 15th-19th. We'll celebrate spring with outdoor sports, nature hikes, and trout fishing at our pond! Vacation Camp is a great way for new campers to try out our program before starting their summer adventure.
